Our event will be aired on May 15-17
On May 10th, A link for the competition stream will be sent to your studio director. Once you click on the link, you will be able to purchase the online competition ticket for online event. Please know that the ticket purchased is not valid on multiple devices. If you share your online ticket, the ticket will no longer be valid.

For our showdown this year, the judge's top scoring five groups and five soloists will qualify. These outstanding performance will be aired at the end of the competition to show our viewers who was our highest scoring routines. We will be doing a live award ceremony at the end of the event on the 17th to announce scores, awards and top titles

Improv solos and photo genic will be judged after filming has occurred. We will also announce the cash winning prize for improv solos and for photo genic in the award ceremony.

Medals, trophies and awards will be delivered to your studio director the following week.

We are fully aware that all studios are doing their best to maintain the 3 m distance rule and cohorts of eight not including any related siblings. We understand that there may be moments where students do make mistakes and come in close contact accidentally. This will not result in any deductions or disqualifications. We are just happy to see the kids try their best in these difficult times.

Follow your cohort schedule done by your director and perform in front of judge.
